2009-2010 NCRHA Team Registration Packet

All materials are to be submitted to your Member Organization. Unless otherwise noted, all materials must be received by your Member Organization by October 15th, 2009 or 72 hours before your team's first game.

Please use the enclosed Team Checklist to ensure that all registration materials have been completed. Your specific Member Organization may have additional registration materials that must be completed before league play can commence. Please consult your league director for details.

If at any time you have any questions or concerns, do not hesitate to contact the league using the information provided in this document.

New documentation has been released for 2009-2010, including an updated League Operations Manual, Rulebook and Bylaws. All documentation is posted online in the NCRHA Document Center at <u>www.ncrha.org</u> under NCRHA Docs.

ITEMS OF NOTE FOR THE 2009-2010 SEASON

1. Continued improvement on Divisional Structure

In 2008-2009, the NCRHA launched the new Divisional Structure. For 2009-2010, some improvements and additional requirements have been made, for all divisions. For more information, download the NCRHA League Operations Manual from the NCRHA Documents section at <u>www.ncrha.org</u> and review the Divisional Requirements section.

2. Inter-Regional Events

The NCRHA, in conjunction with all NCRHA Member Organizations, will be working to bring Division I teams (as well as all other divisions, pending availability) several opportunities to compete in Inter-Regional Events during the season. Information will be announced on <u>www.ncrha.org</u> as soon as it is available. In 2008-2009, over 25 teams travelled to neighboring Member Organizations to participate in Inter-Regional play. 16 Division I teams, 6 Division II teams, and 6 B Division teams took part in this experience, and therefore better prepared themselves for the National Championship Tournament.

3. NCRHA Winterfest

The NCRHA will once again bring you Winterfest, held in Key West, Florida in early January. This is an open-invitation tournament to all NCRHA Active Members. The dates and further details will be posted at <u>www.ncrha.org</u> as soon as they are available.

4. NCRHA National Championships

The NCRHA is working towards securing sites and dates for the next 2 National Championship Tournaments. These things take time, so we are asking for your patience.

5. Continued NCRHA Marketing/PR

The NCRHA was represented at both Narch Finals and State Wars for the past 3 years. Nanette Houser, NCRHA Director of Marketing, was in attendance with the NCRHA College Information Station at State Wars. Bill Bourque from the ECRHA, Shippensburg University alumni, was in attendance with the Information Station at NARCh Finals. The NCRHA realizes that youth are the future of our sport, and that our presence at these large events is crucial to our overall longevity. We are also "doing our part" to keep interest alive in the sport of roller hockey. We are there to show these young players that they can continue playing all the way through high school and into college.

The NCRHA is working with one of their sponsors, Mission Hockey, to bring you a Mission Hockey College at an event in your area. 19 Mission Hockey Colleges have been held over the past 2 seasons. The Mission Hockey College is a clinic for the youth of the area to come out and skate with college roller hockey players and be mentored on improving skills, etc. Your Member Organization Director will be contacted in order to get you involved in helping out with this event. 6. NCRHA Division at NARCh

For the 3rd consecutive year, NARCh has hosted an NCRHA Division at their championship event. This year's event was held at the Hershey Centre in Mississauga, Ontario, Canada. 4 teams representing 4 NCRHA Member Organizations attended the event. The Midwest Collegiate Roller Hockey League team was crowned champion, defeating the ECRHA team in the finals. WCRHL earned the bronze medal, and SCHL was the 4th place team. Past champions are ECRHA (2008, San Jose, CA) and GPCIHL (2007, Fort Myers, FL).

7. Payments

- All payments are to be submitted to your Member Organization. They will be invoicing you for both your Regular Season and for your NCRHA Registration Fees. No payments are necessary to the NCRHA, except for the NCRHA Winterfest and National Championships.
- National Championships Fees All fees paid for entrance to the National Championships (or Winter Invitational) will be subject to the following refund criteria: 50% refund with 2 weeks notification; No refund with less than 2 weeks notification; Alternates fully refundable unless they accept a spot from a dropped team.
- The NCRHA continues it's policy of not accepting personal checks. The NCRHA will be collecting a \$25 fee for all NSF (insufficient funds) checks.



To all players, staff, parents, alumni,

Welcome to another exciting season of collegiate roller hockey. 2009-2010 marks the 15th year that a collegiate roller hockey champion has been crowned, and the 12th year that a national governing body for collegiate roller hockey has officially sanctioned the sport and held a "True National Championship."

We had a great National Championship Tournament in Feasterville, Pennsylvania last April. 56 teams from across the nation again competed to be crowned champion in 4 divisions. The event was held at The Sportsplex, Three first-time champions were crowned at this event. The University of Missouri St. Louis Tritons defeated the Lindenwood University Lions in Division I; Grand Valley State University Lakers defeated the Central Michigan Chippewas in Division II; Saddleback College Gauchos defeated St. Charles CC Cougars in the Junior College Division; and Lindenwood University Lions defeated the Penn State University Nittany Lions in the B Division. Thank you goes out to all of the teams that competed and helped make this event a success, and one of our best yet!

Once again, you will be asked to submit your registration paperwork no later than October 15th or 72 hours before your first game of the season, whichever occurs first. All completed registration materials are to mailed or handed to your Member Organization Director, not to the NCRHA office.

If you look at the checklist provided on the following pages, you will have a comprehensive listing of everything you need to do to prepare for the upcoming season. Due dates for paperwork are included where applicable. Do not hesitate to submit anything you have completed before the due date – we appreciate having completed materials early. Your Member Organization may have several documents in addition to this packet that are required in order to register.

A Letter of Recognition of the team as an official student organization is to be submitted by the due date on the checklist. An administrator at your school must complete this and sign with their information. Additionally, forms have been provided to verify that all players on your team are taking the requisite number of credits at your school. Please note that these forms must be completed for ALL players on the roster. They must be signed and/or stamped by your registrar to be accepted.

Please, use the web site tools that have been provided for you! I am always surprised at the number of high school players who write NCRHA and already know everything about the roller hockey teams at the schools they are considering. Make sure your information on the website is updated and post articles regularly. Additionally, use the PPS Administration Area to check on the status of your registration paperwork. A short summary on using PPS is provided in this packet.

Lastly, we have assessed last year's divisional changes and have made some improvements and further changes to them. This should make for an exciting season! No longer are teams placed into a division based solely on their school size. The teams themselves have chosen where to participate, based on a number of criteria. Overall, the NCRHA believes that this will be good for the sport!

Finally, good luck to all teams in the upcoming 2009-2010 season. See you on the rink!

Once again, the NCRHA has contracted with PowerPlayStats[™] (PPS) to bring you updated standings, stats and scores. Below is a brief summary of the areas online that you will need to keep up-to-date this year, as well as instructions on how to do so.

Logging In

Go to your member organization site or NCRHA.org and click on the PPS icon. Click on "Admin Login" at the bottom of the page. You will be brought to the PPS login page. Your login is tied to your email address. Enter your email address and password (same as last year). If you have forgotten your password, you can have a new one sent to you by clicking the "Forgot Password" link immediately below the login box. If you are a brand new team or don't know if you have an email address set up, contact PPS at support@powerplaystats.com or your Member Organization Director for your login information.

Changing Your Password

Chances are good that you'll never remember the password that was created for you. After logging in, click on the "My Account" section on the top right and update your password through the "Change Password" button.

League and Content Menus

The main two pull-down menus to be concerned with are League and Content. Those will lead you to adding players to your roster, posting news articles about your team, etc. Please feel free to explore all of the drop-down menus as soon as possible, to ease your familiarity with the site. Online Registration

The NCRHA and its Member Organizations have set up regional Online Registration websites. The SCHL and SECRHL have been doing this for several seasons. This season, all Member Organizations will be using Online Registration, in addition to the documents within this Team Registration Packet.

All players, coaches and other team staff must register on this site. All registered users will enter their email address, emergency contact information, etc. This will enable League Officials on-site to have access to your emergency contact information, should it be necessary, and with your approval. Having your email address on file will allow your Member Organization and the NCRHA to include you in their mailings, which will include news articles from around the nation, sponsorship/vendor details, league news such as bids to the National Championship Tournament, etc.

The following is the process for online registration for each player.

- 2. Click on Registration (left side of page)
- 3. Click on the "Click here" link next to New Player or New Coach. (Other team staff should register as a coach.
- 4. Using the tabs under "Registration New Player" (or "Coach"), enter in all required information.
- 5. Once finished, click the "Submit" tab. Then click on the "Submit" button.

**Should you have any issues, contact your League Director for more information.

**Team Representatives – League Directors will distribute information to Team Representatives on managing your team on your registration website. Team Representatives will have further responsibilities once all players are in and the team rep access has been granted. Team Representatives will have the ability to log in and view the eligibility of each player on their team at any time.

 - The signature must be accompanied by a title, address and phone number at which the representative can be reached
